AMENDMENT TO THE LAND USE BYLAW

NOTICE is hereby given that at its meeting to be held on **TUESDAY, April 28, 2020**, the Council of Red Deer County will consider **Bylaw No. 2020/2.02** to redesignate Lot: Building C, Block: Area A, Plan 0124151, SE 14-37-28-4 (0.775 hectares / 1.29 acres) from Business Service Airport District (BSA) to Business Service Industrial District (BSI).

The purpose of this bylaw is to accommodate a future automotive dealership that includes light mechanical work/servicing on this property that is located in the Hamlet of Springbrook at 3508 – 37 Avenue (Airport Drive) adjacent to the Red Deer Regional Airport.

The permitted and discretionary uses and other matters presently applicable to BSA and BSI districts are contained in the Land Use Bylaw.
