AMENDMENT TO THE LAND USE BYLAW

NOTICE is hereby given that at its meeting to be held on **TUESDAY, June 23, 2020**, the Council of Red Deer County will consider **Bylaw No. 2020/2.03** to redesignate 38.37 hectares / 94.82 acres of NW 12-37-28-4 from Agricultural District (Ag) to Public Service District (PS).

The purpose of this bylaw is to align this parcel of land with its current land use (Springbrook Park/Trails Area), which is located adjacent to the south of the Hamlet of Springbrook.

The permitted and discretionary uses and other matters presently applicable to Ag and PS districts are contained in the LUB.

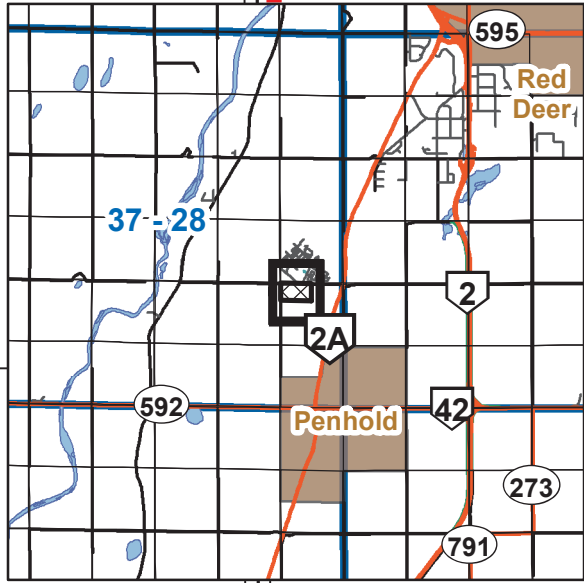
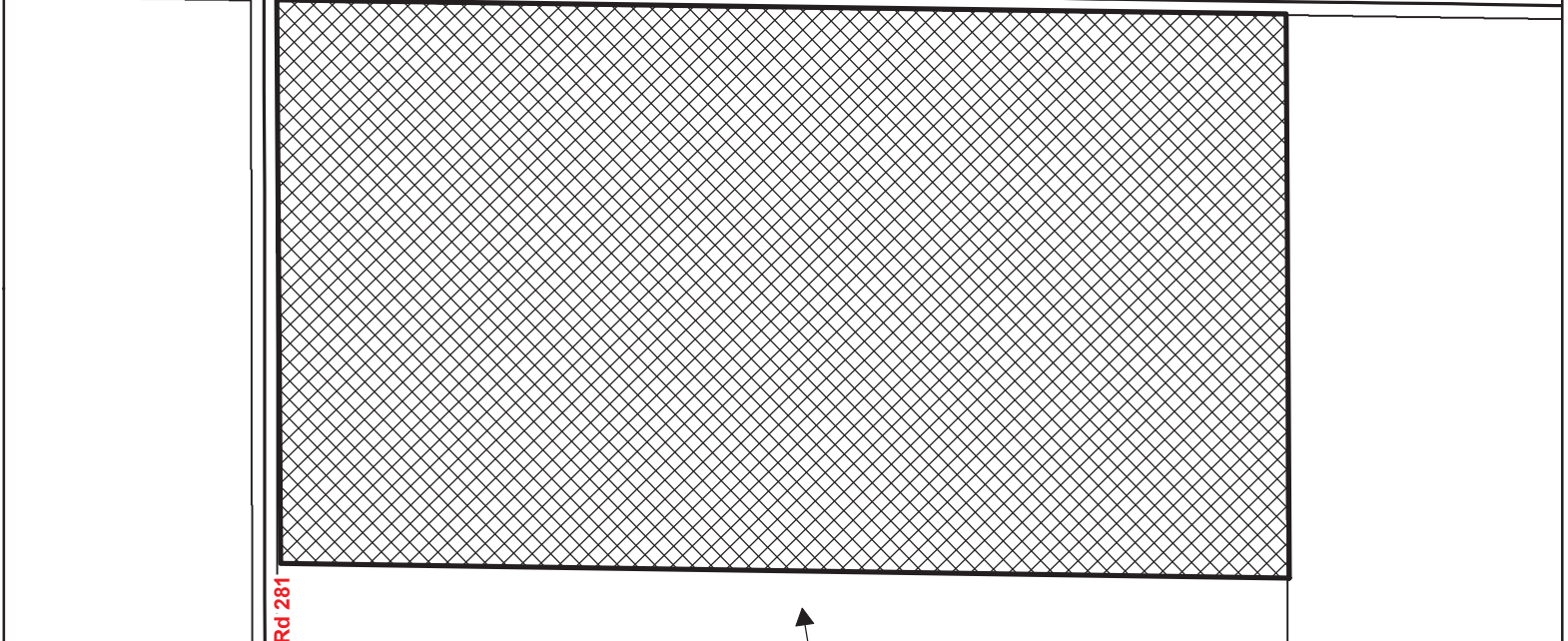
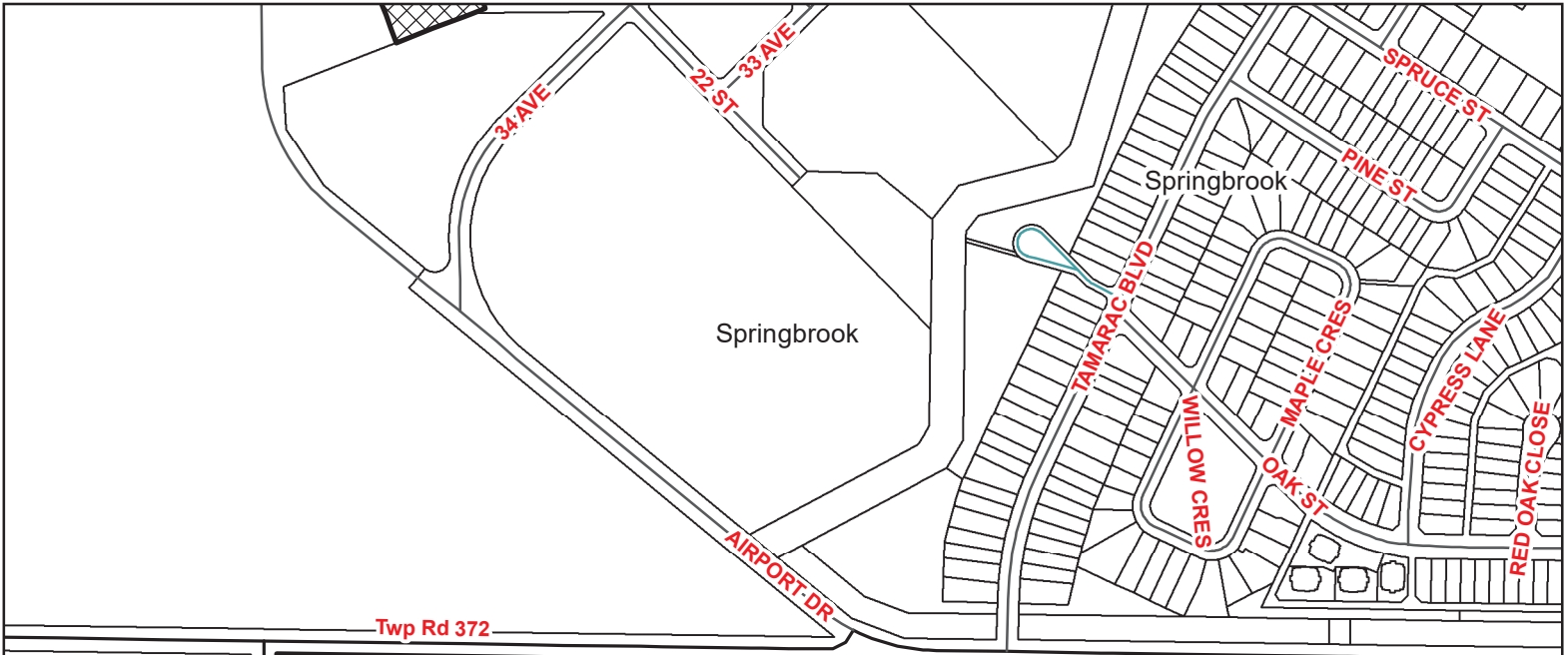
