Bylaw No. 2022/2.11 to redesignate Pt SE 01-39-01-5 from Agricultural District (Ag) to Direct Control District #26 (DCD-26)

The permitted and discretionary uses and other matters presently applicable to the land use districts are contained in the Red Deer County Land Use Bylaw No. 2006/6.

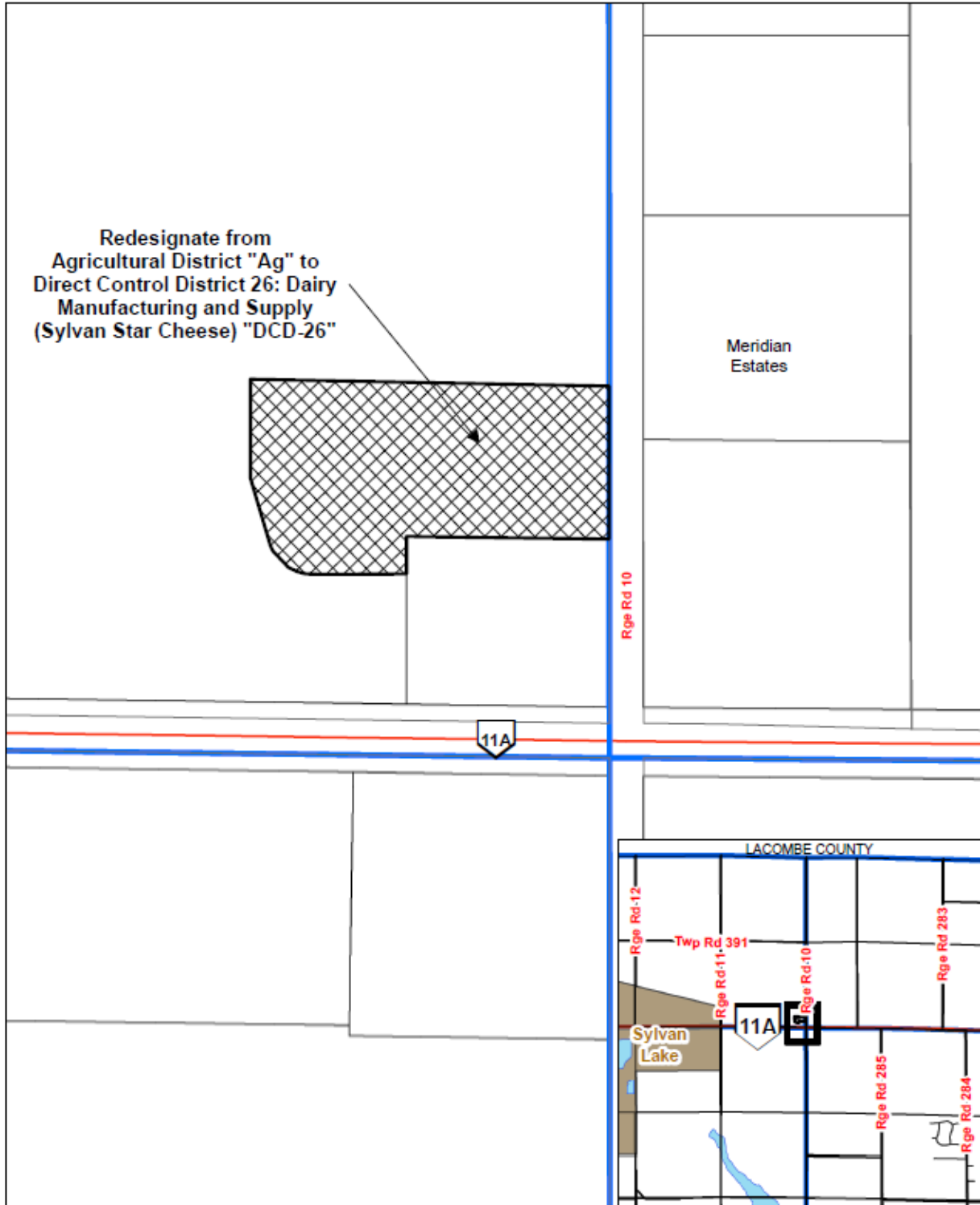
