Bylaw No. 2023/26.2 to redesignate 1.58 ha (3.90 acres) of NE 32-38-28-4 from Agricultural District to Country Residential District

The primary intent of the bylaw is to facilitate a future subdivision.

The permitted and discretionary uses and other matter presently applicable to the land use districts are contained in Red Deer County Land Use Bylaw No. 2022/26.
